1. Sit in a circle in **groups of six**.
2. Each take a sheet, write your name on it and then **trace your hand** on the back of the sheet.

5. **Pass the sheet** around to the person on your left and repeat step five.
6. On the sixth pass around, you'll **get your original hand drawing** back.
7. Read the things the group have said that **make you brilliant**.
